

PGWGC 9 Hole Group

Purpose and General Guidelines

Purpose:

Afford ladies that are beginning to play golf an opportunity to play in tournament formats where they must learn the rules of golf and golf etiquette and to establish handicaps which they must have to join any golf club.

Provide ladies who no longer wish or are unable to play a full 18 holes the opportunity to play in a tournament format.

The City of Pacific Grove recognizes only three clubs: Men's Club, Seniors Club and PGWGC (Ladies Club). The 9 hole group operates under the umbrella of the PGWGC as "Associate Members" and pays the PGWGC annual dues. Associate members may participate in PGWGC invitational and all social events sponsored by the PGWGC.

Membership:

The membership will be limited to 40 active players. In order to stay active, a member should play at least 12 games per calendar year and be starter/scorer a minimum of two times per year.

All members are required to pay annual membership dues as stipulated on club membership new and renewal applications. Notifications will be sent out by the Membership Chair.

Honorary, non-paying memberships can be established, at the discretion of the Board, for long time members who are seldom able to play. Honorary members who play are not eligible for sweeps.

All members are requested to pay a \$5.00 administrative fee per year to help cover printing costs and social events. The fee should be paid to the Treasurer upon joining or before January 31 each year.

Our club has two organized social events per calendar year - one in the summertime and the December Holiday End-of-Year awards party.

The Board:

The officers shall consist of Captain, Co-Captain/Membership and Treasurer/Secretary. The officers will be elected at the end-of-year meeting and Christmas Luncheon in December.

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Play days:

Play days are on Mondays. We are authorized a field of 24 or 6 tee times. On the rare occasion that all the fields are filled, players may sign up as alternates. Alternate players should call the Pro Shop the day before to check on any cancellations.

Players shall sign up for play days with the Pro Shop before 7 AM the day of play.

Players who need to cancel must do so by calling the Pro Shop no later than 7 AM on play days.

Starter/scorer should arrive at 7:45. If starter/scorer cannot fulfill their obligation, they are required to find a replacement before the date of play. The Tournament Box with all instructions for starting/scoring as well as the sign up sheets are in the Pro Shop.

On the day of play, players must be signed in prior to 8:30 AM.

The Starter/Scorer designates teams & tee assignments.

Each player pays \$2 which is divided: \$1.50 for sweeps; \$.25 for chip-ins, \$.25 for the club's general fund.

Teams will keep two scorecards and have two separate scorers. Scorecards will have the names of all players, be accurate and be signed and attested by the scorers. Scorecards that are incorrect, illegible or lack proper signatures risk being disqualified from the tournament results.

A rain call will be made before 7:00 AM. Players will be notified by email or can call the pro shop.

Break a tie by combining the winnings of the placements and share with the persons who have tied.

All players are responsible for posting their own scores each week.

All play will be in accordance to USGA Rules.
